

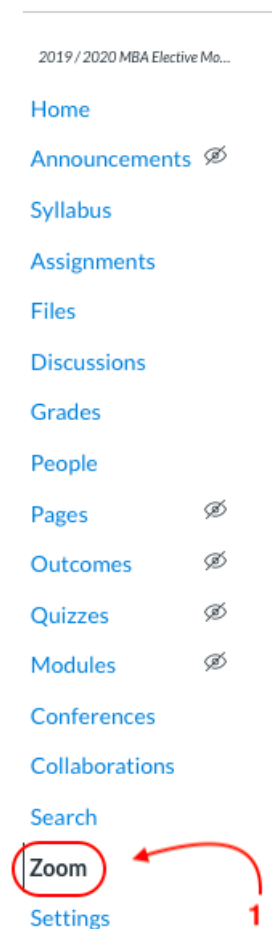
Publish Zoom Cloud Recordings in Canvas
